Franny Strikes Again



Although the Galva Wildcat Football team did not capture the Lincoln Trail Conference championship as they had expected at the beginning of the 1984 campaign, they did have a successful season and should be proud of their efforts.

Under head coach Tom Buck, the Wildcats began the season with a thrilling overtime victory over Aledo and then shut out Erie 12-0 to take a 2-0 record into conference play. However, the conference was full of talented teams and the Cats could not shrug off the numerous injuries that plagued them after the first two games. They dropped consecutive games to Wethersfield, Toulon, and Alexis, but came back strong to win their Homecoming against ROVA 27-6, and demolish Winola 33-14. After a loss to Alwood, they ended the season with an impressive victory over Cambridge. The team finished 5-4 overall, and their 3-4 record in the conference was good enough for a 4th place finish.

The Wildcat offense gained 1,465 yards rushing and 626 yards passing for a total of 2,091 yards while averaging 232 yards per game. The Cats posted three players to 1st Team All-Conference: Alex Darragh (offense and defense), Todd Stewart (defense), and Tim Kernc (defense). Rob Strand was an Honorable Mention All-Conference selection on both offense and defense. They were also honored with selections to the All-Western Illinois team: Todd Stewart (1st team defense), Alex Darragh (2nd team defense), and Tim Kernc (Special Mention).







At the beginning of the 1984-85 basketball season, Galva was not favored to win the Lincoln Trail Conference as they had the previous year. They were not even expected to finish second or third by local newspapers. But under head coach Gene Hulick, the Wildcats used those predictions as motivation and worked hard all season to win the conference for the third consecutive year, posting a 13-1 record.

The Cats started off the season with big victories over Toulon and Yates City before losing to the host Bombers in the championship of the Williamsfield Tournament. The team lost a very close game to Kewanee but won consecutive games against Annawan, Sherrard, and Atkinson to take a 5-2 record into the Bradford Holiday Tournament. The Cats lost their first game against Wyanet but still won the Consolation Championship.

The Wildcats lost the first game in conference play, but then went on a streak of 13 straight wins to capture the LTC. Sadly, they lost their first game of the Regional to Kewanee, which brought a quick end to a successful season. They finished with a 20-5 record and were ranked 16th in Illinois by the Associated Press. Brad Hulick was named 1st Team All-Conference. Todd Stewart and Todd Hannam were named 2nd Team All-Conference. Brad was also elected 1st Team All-Western Illinois and Honorable Mention All-State.

The Frosh-Soph squad lost some very close games early in the year, but finished up the season strong by capturing the Consolation Championship at the Atkinson Tournament. Led by coach John Smith, they finished 9-5 in the conference and 12-11 overall.





The year featured three broken school records and a tie.* The team received the following places in area meets; 6th - Westwood Invitational, 10th - Wethersfield Relays, 5th - Princeville Relays, 8th - FS Conference, 3rd Conference, 6th Alwood Invitational, 9th Roseville Relays, 10th - District Meet.

The highlight of the season came when the 1600 meter relay team got First Place out of 23 teams at the District Track Meet in Sherrard and qualified for the State Track Meet in Charleston. The 800 meter relay team took a painful Third Place and missed going to state by less than a second. The mile relay team proceeded to break their own record and place 10th at the State meet.

Other places at the District Track Meet included: 400 meter relay - 4th place, Eric Maki in Long Jump - 4th place.


